

Annex 2 – Evaluation form for the Call for EUTOPIA_HEALTH Cross-University Mobility Programme for Young Researchers

The proposal contains two parts which will be taken in consideration by the evaluators:

- Part A Curriculum vitae and track record record of the researcher applying for the mobility
- Part B Research & Innovation proposal.



Evaluation criteria

Part A - Curriculum vitae and track record of the researcher applying for the mobility (30%)

- Evaluators will consider relevance of the applicant's research track record, including publications, fellowships, collaborations, conference participation, and other relevant achievements in relation to the proposal.
- Special attention should be given to skills and experience that are crucial for the success of the proposed project, and to innovative and inter/transdisciplinary approaches.
- Projects where the researcher played a prominent role are highly valued.

Score: 0/30 Threshold: 15/30

Part B – Research & innovation proposal (70%)

B.1. Aim and objectives of the research mobility (30 %)

• Evaluators will assess the clarity and pertinence of the research mobility's aims and main objectives, in the context of the current state of knowledge in the relevant field, focusing on the scientific concept, originality of the proposal, and transdisciplinary approach of the proposed research.

Score: 0/30 Threshold: 15/30

B.2. Detailed Research plan (40 %)

- Evaluators should assess the detailed research plan, project timeline, including the specific methodology and the feasibility and effectiveness of the project.
- Evaluators should evaluate the expected outcomes of the research, such as potential scientific advancements, practical applications, or contributions to the broader body of knowledge.
- Evaluators will assess how the project aligns with the research focus of the Host institution and how the mobility experience will benefit the applicant's research development.
- Evaluators should assess the expertise of the supervisor from the Host institution and how it sustains the success of the project will be evaluated.

Score: 0/40 Threshold: 20/40

Outcome of the evaluation

- Each proposal will be evaluated and marked for each of the two main elements of the proposal (Part A and Part B).
- At the end of the evaluation step, the proposals will be ranked by the panel on the basis of the scores (1-100 points) they have received and the panels' overall appreciation of their strengths and weaknesses.
- The applicant will be notified via email regarding the status of their application (funded/not funded) based on the points they have accumulated during the evaluation process.
