1. Short “connecting-mobilities”

- at least 30 **short term mobilities of 2-4 days** for academic staff and/or researchers within the EUTOPIA_HEALTH consortium¹, promoting the share of best practices, establishing collaborations;
- sender or host institution: one of the three Widening member of the EUTOPIA_HEALTH consortium - **Babeş-Bolyai University** (UBB, Romania), **NOVA University of Lisbon** (Nova, Portugal), **University of Ljubljana** (UL, Slovenia) (~10 mobilities/ university);
- period: 01.01.2025-30.06.2027
- beneficiaries: **researchers** of the EUTOPIA_HEALTH consortium interested in collaborations on health-related topics.

2. Young-researchers Mobility Program

- **mid-term (up to 5 months)** mobilities across the EUTOPIA_HEALTH consortium for **young researchers** (PhD students, early-career researchers) from the Widening members (NOVA, UBB, UL) to other consortium members;
- young researchers will have the possibility to further develop health-related, trans/interdisciplinary and/or **specific skills** under the guidance of ≥ 2 research group leaders;
- **25 mobility-months**/Widening member university;
- period: 01.12.2024-30.06.2028;
- beneficiaries: PhD students, early career researchers (with ≤ 8 years after PhD) of the Widening member universities (NOVA, UBB, UL) of the EUTOPIA_HEALTH consortium.

3. Seed-funding for new research clusters of Health

- support to **transdisciplinary, collaborative research projects** focusing on Health-related challenges implemented at the Widening universities of the EUTOPIA_HEALTH consortium (NOVA, UBB, UL);
- the collaborative research should involve a **minimum of 3 research groups** from different EUTOPIA_HEALTH consortium universities, including at least one Widening member with funding being offered for the Widening partner for a two-year period;
- allocated budget: **120,000 EUR** / project (60,000 EUR/year), with a total of **2 projects funded at each Widening university** of the consortium;
- period: 01.01.2026-30.06.2028;
- beneficiaries: *i)* researchers, young or established group-leaders from Widening universities of the EUTOPIA_HEALTH consortium, who can benefit from financing, establishment of collaborations, etc.; *ii)* researchers from the non-Widening members of the consortium can benefit from collaborations, knowledge exchange and involvement in the health-related research community of the consortium.
