1. Strategy of the Seminars

As part of its external communications axes, EUTOPIA includes the engagement of debate with external experts on three identified challenges the alliance tackles: a new model of Education, an efficient Inclusion policy, and the road towards scientific diplomacy.

EUTOPIA plans three sessions, with the specific purpose to propose solutions for the future and ideal academia.

2. Audiences

1. European Commission's officers with decision-making authority;
2. other pilot European Universities;
3. higher-education representatives willing to participate.

3. Objective

Present and debate with the EC's representatives' solutions for the future's university designed by EUTOPIA. Obtain feedback.

2:30 hours sessions, with short presentations at the beginning and debate afterwards.
